Transmitter : Continental 317-C2 **Frequency:** 1.020 – Mhz

Power: 50 Killowatts DA/N

Antenna: Six Tower phased array, each tower is 250-feet in height
located on a 30-acre field North of Roswell, New Mexico.

Pattern: **Day:** North lobe at 340 degrees, South lobe at 170 Degrees

Night: North lobe at 340 degrees, South lobe at 175 Degrees
with a deep null at 270 degrees, and deep null at 30
degrees.

Automation: We operate a SCOTT STUDIOS automation system for unmanned
operation during night time hours.

This station has been operating since the mid 1970's. Our studios are combined
with our sister FM stations KBCQ, KMOU, and KSFX.
