Thank you for your letter of reception of our new station, just one month old.

Presently we are on low power, with some problems in our modulation reactor (shorted turns) which prevent our broadcasting on high power; hopefully the new part will arrive early next week and we will be glad to leave our low power of 500 watts.

I am pleased to confirm your report of reception which is entirely accurate.

Our next scheduled frequency test with Vir James is Monday morning, from midnight to 1:00 A.M. We certainly should be on high power by that time.

I built KRKS (formerly KLIR) in 1953; put it on the air in August of 1953- sold it a year later; should have kept it.
