Thanks again, and please drop us a note sometime during the later part of December reporting our nighttime reception in Englewood.

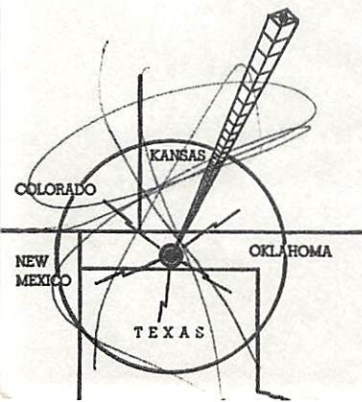

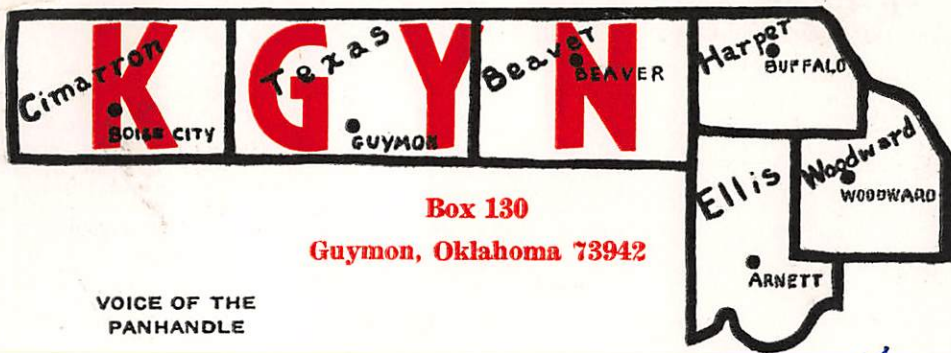
