Dear Mr. Nittler:

Thanks for your reception report! Yours is the first I know of received from Colorado, or any point in the United States as far east as that, since we are a daytime station; it's quite impressive that you pulled us in, even briefly, a full hour before our January 5:00 pm signoff...and at the end of the month, yet! (This month, we sign off at 5:45, and until the middle of the month it'll be fairly dark by the time we sign off then, which presumably would be the most favorable time to pick us up at a distance.)

KWIP is a 5 kw nondirectional station (500 watts presunrise) on 1460 kHz, with studio and transmitter located two miles east of Dallas, Oregon--about 12 miles west of the state capitol of Oregon, Salem. We transmit with a 200-foot steel guyed tower, shunt fed by a Gates BC-5P transmitter.

I'm pleased to confirm that the details you provide match our log for the 3:57-3:59 pm PST time period on January 28, 1982, and consequently I verify that you did receive KWIP radio on that date and at that time at your location in Colorado.
