Dear Mr. Nittler,

I'm happy to report your reception of our station on Monday Morning October 14 on the legal testing period was correct. We were testing to align our transmitters and keep things in good running shape. We signed on to test at 2:00AM and continued until 5:30AM. The rock music you heard was not typical of the music ordinarily programmed on KCHF. During our broadcast day we program beautiful music. We are a Am-FM simulcast station with the following facilities.

- AM- CCA 500watt transmitter  
output- 500 watts  
Antenna hight 150ft.
- FM- Gates with stereo exciter  
output- 3000watts max. 2200 used  
erp- 3000watts with three bay antenna  
on top of our Am tower.

Seeing as how we are only 150ft. you were quite lucky to be able to receive us. We broadcast from sunrise to sunset on AM and 6:00 untill midnight on FM. Thanks very much for your letter.
