Dear Bill:

This letter will confirm your reception of KTOQ radio on February 11, 1980 from 12:28 to 12:30 AM MST. We were performing our monthly frequency measurement at the time you reported receiving us. We were operating during the experimental period and running 1 kW of power at the time.

KTOQ operates 1 kW day and 250 W night with a Harris MW-1A main transmitter and a Gates BC-1T standby (auxiliary) transmitter. Our antenna is a 300' folded unipole. The transmitter site is a couple of miles east of Rapid City in a swampy area. Studios are, of course, in downtown Rapid City.

Thank you so much for the reception report. We have been getting quite a few of these lately, so skywave must be pretty good on the BC band lately. I wish you the best DX'ing.
