There must be some mistake on your hearing K.E.G.G. on the date of March 8, 1974, as we were not on the air at the time mentioned by you, however we were on the air at 12:01 AM April 8, 1974 until 1:29 AM the same date making a performance check and if you received our signal on that date you should have received the signal tone we were feeding into the transmitter.

For a supply of information for what it is worth, we are using an A.E.L. transmitter with 1000 watts daytime the finals are 1-400 with the grids driven by a 6146 with a frequency constant of less than .1 khz usually we maintain a frequency of absolute zero. Our console is Sparta equipped with audicmax compressor and limiter and Wilkinson frequency monitored.
