This is to verify that you did indeed hear our signal September 9, 1961 on emergency broadcasting with music and hurricane Cañla alerts .

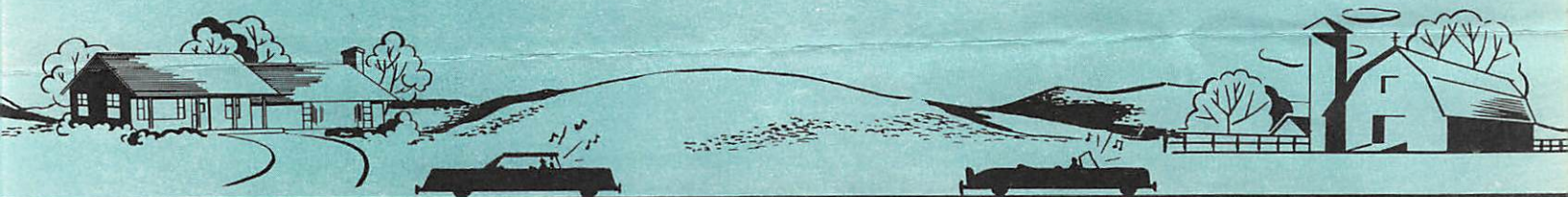
