We wish to express our appreciation for your reception report of February 1, 1959. It has been confirmed by our program department.

K-JIM's combined studio-transmitter facilities are located at the Trinity River in Riverside near downtown Fort Worth. The antenna is a 285 foot tapered, self-supporting, series excited, vertical steel radiator. 180 equally spaced, buried copper radials, 300 feet in length comprise the ground system. Raytheon studio and transmitter components make up the basic equipment structure.
