Many thanks for your reception report of KLIF dated August 8, 1954. Since your report agrees with our program log, we are happy to send you this letter of verification.

KLIF commenced broadcasting as a 1000 watt daytime station on November 9, 1947. Since then rapid strides have been taken and we now operate 'round the clock with a power of 5000 watts non-directional during the day and 1000 watts directional at night. KLIF uses a Continental type 315 transmitter manufactured by the Continental Electronics Manufacturing Company of Dallas. This transmitter employs grid-bias modulation of the final stage which operates as a Doherty high-efficiency amplifier.

The antenna system consists of five Wincharger uniform cross-section towers on a line bearing 112 degrees true. These towers are 225 feet high and spaced 378 feet from the adjacent tower(s).
