Sorry for the delay in answering your reception report, but things have been a bit hectic around the ole station this past week. Your log of items received is accurate. Jim D'Arc is an expert in musical nostalgia and travels the world looking for those out of print records as well as records which are part of music history, yet are not commonly known by the general public.

KRQX operates at 570 khz and has a power of 5,000 watts, 24 hours a day. We broadcast in AM Stereo thorugh the Motorola system and were the first to do so in Dallas and in Texas with a stereo sin-on date of June 6, 1983.

I have also enclosed some items using the old call letters WFAA and included some collectables from our FM, 98, KZEW, otherwise known to locals as "The Zoo". The zoo operates at 97.9 FM at a power of 100,000 watts.
