This will acknowledge your reception report of this station December 6, 1995 between 6:13 and 6:21 AM PST. There is no question that you were indeed listening to KLFE at 1590 Khz on that occasion. At the time we were operating at 5,000 watts, with our nighttime directional pattern. During daylight hours KLFE operates non-directional, 5,000 watts. Thank you for the fine report.

My personal hobbies are Ham radio (K7VCD), serious photography, camping, reading, and 10 grandchildren!! My favorite sports are ice hockey, football and baseball.

KLFE is owned and operated by Salem Communications Corporation, with headquarters near Los Angeles, California. The corporation owns thirty-one (31) AM & FM stations across the United States. Most of the stations are located in major cities, that include Boston, New York City, Washington D-C, Pittsburgh, Columbus (Ohio), Chicago, Los Angeles, San Diego, San Francisco, Portland (Oregon), Colorado Springs, Seattle, Houston, Dallas, and Philaelpia.

Our studios are located in an office building downtown Seattle, and programming audio is sent to the transmitters via microwave and telephone line. The transmitters are operated by remote control, thus there is no need for an operator at the transmitter site. The transmitter site is on Bainbridge Island in the middle of Puget Sound, directly west of downtown Seattle.

Our programming, as you probably discovered, is Christian programming. Again, thank you so much for your very fine report.
