Dear Mr. Nittler:

I am happy to confirm your reception of WLCX at Englewood.

It is rather surprising to me that we could come through since there is so much interference on 1490. We were operating under emergency conditions during a record blizzard and were using 1000 watts. (Night power on a class IV channel is limited to 250 watts.)

I used to be on the engineering staff at KOA. I started there in 1933 when they were 12.5 KW. Helped install the 50 KW rig and then went to the California Street studio where I was in studio engineering and remote pickup work. Was at KOA until 1946 when I went to Colorado Springs and put in my own station, KRDO. Put channel 13 TV on at KRDO in 1953 and was owner of the station.

By the way I have been an amateur operator since 1926. If you enjoy listening to radio, you should really be fascinated by two way conversations with everyplace in the world. Why don't you look into it? Recently I was in a QSO with a station on each of the six continents, all at the same time.....could read everyone and they read me!
