This letter will verify your reception of our station back on Septmeber 13th., 1955.

We are truly sorry that this letter was not sent earlier, but at least we had no intention of forgetting yours, and 15 others from DX'ers like yourself. The letters were lost for some time, and found just recently.


According to your report, you monitored our station while we were making a frequency check for RCA Monitoring Service at Riverhead, Long Island. This was done during the period our station frequency monitor was being changed over from 1050 to 1260 kcs. at the Gates factory.

WOKW made it official changeover from 1050kcs @250 watts to 1260 kcs. @ 1000 watts at 12:15 PM C-S-T August 17th. 1955. In the year (almost) that we've been on we have had no major trouble other than a filament transformer blowing up. This however did occur befor we went on for final tests and was replaced befor the final test date.

We are using a Gates BC-1, 1000 watt rig pushing a 229foot tower, which is guyed. Our final output is taken from a pair of 833-A tubes. Our tower is located on swampy ground---which of course does wonders to the signal output.

Sorry again that this letter wasn't sent our earlier, Thanks too for your patience.
