DEAR MR. NITTLER:

THANK YOU FOR THE RESPONSE (RECEPTION) LETTER OF SEPTEMBER 6TH. YOUR LOG IS ACCURATE.

KVWO BROADCASTS ON A FREQUENCY OF 1530 KHZ, AT POWERS OF 10,000 WATTS NONDIRECTIONAL DAYTIME, 5,000 WATTS DIRECTIONAL CRITICAL HOURS, AND 1,000 WATTS DIRECTIONAL NIGHT TIME. THE 1530 FREQUENCY, TRANSMITTERS, ANTENNAS AND RELATED EQUIPMENT WERE PURCHASED FROM PREVIOUS OWNERS OF KRNK -- PREVIOUSLY KNIE, KCHY AND OTHERS. AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE, THE OVERALL BROADCAST EQUIPMENT WAS IN A STATE OF EXTREME DISREPAIR. SLOWLY, BUT SURELY, WE ARE REPLACEING AND/OR REPAIRING ALMOST EVERY EQUIPMENT ITEM IN THE 1530 BROADCAST MAKEUP. WE HAVE ADDED A HARRIS PHASEMASTER, AN OPTOMOD AUDIO PROCESSOR, A BELARE AM MODULATION MONITOR, NEW MODULATORS IN THE HARRIS 5/10K TRANSMITTER. TOWER (ANTENNA) WELDING AND TUNING. WE ARE REDESIGNING THE RADIAL/GROUNDING SYSTEM. WE HAVE PLANS FOR MORE. BUT AS YOU MIGHT GUESS, ALL OF THIS EQUIPMENT REQUIRES A CONSIDERABLE CASH OUTLAY. BUT HOPEFULLY, WHEN EVERYTHING IS COMPLETE, OUR SIGNAL WILL EQUAL OR EXCEED ANYTHING IN THE REGION OF EQUIVILANT POWER.

I AM NOT ABLE TO ANSWER YOUR INQUIRIES INTO KRNK OR KNIE BROADCAST ACTIVITIES. FROM THE ENGINEERING STANDPOINT, THEIR RESPECTIVE SIGNALS WERE DOING WELL TO GET OUT OF TOWN. AS FOR KVWO, IF WE ARE GOING TO DO IT, WE ARE GOING TO DO IT RIGHT...
