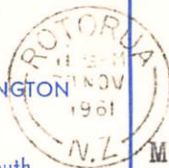

Thank you for your letter and reception report which we are happy to confirm.

You may be interested to know that our 10 kw transmitter is located at Paengaroa some 25 miles south of Tauranga. The transmitter buildings and also a 500 foot vertical radiator are shared with 1YZ Rotorua. Tauranga itself is a city of some 20,000. A few miles away the rapidly expanding port of Mount Maunganui is the main outlet for newsprint, pulp etc. from the large softwood forests south of Rotorua.
