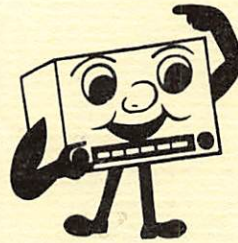

Forgive me for being tardy in getting back to you. Your letter to WVLE-FM was post-marked August 25, so I apologize for the lapse of time.


