Thank you for your letter regarding your reception of WQEN (Q-104, as we call it) on May 21st. Q-104 is Alabama's most powerful station with 100,000 watts from an antenna just under 2,000 feet above sea level. We cover all of North and Central Alabama, Northwest Georgia, Southeast Tennessee and part of Mississippi. We have been heard in Kentucky, North Carolina, South Carolina, Florida, Illinois, and Indiana. This is our first reception report from Nebraska and I find your report of our programming to be quite accurate.
