This confirms your reception of our FM radio signal on July 7, 1985.

This is, I believe, the farthest west we have ever had a report of the reception of our signal. We operate with 100,000 watts ERP. The previous record was from a man who lives in Fort Smith (all the way across the state), who listened to the Metropolitan Opera on KASU on Saturday afternoons. In the other direction, we heard from a DXer in Massachusetts several years ago.
