Thank you for your report of receiving the KVCR (FM) signal on January 25, 1979. This letter confirms your report of programs/personalities/comments made on 1-25.

It may be of interest to you that I had occasion to watch KLNE-TV (CH 3) from Lexington, Nebraska, on this same evening. Since San Bernardino is about 60 miles east of Los Angeles, most VHF Antennas are aimed due west. The signal from Channel 3 was as clear as a local station, and considering that it came through my antenna from the "backside", I was really hard pressed to believe what I was watching. I was watching a local call-in program on Ch 3 and caught the phone number (they even mentioned area code 402). So I called and found out the station is affiliated with P.B.S. The next morning I sent them a teletype message regarding what had happened the night before.
