5:52 P.M. PST Rock music, "Stayin' Alive" and "Somebody Help Me"

5:55 "Kidsy 96, KYXY San Diego".

A Test of the Emergency Broadcast System followed followed by a brief explanation and mention, "KYXY serves the San Diego area". Music, "When You Come Home". Signal then faded.

Your signal was coming in with follow Very good at first. 10 California st rare skip opening.


Would appreciate it very much if you verification on my reception of your a self-addressed, stamped envelope for Thank you very much for this favor.

Although I have been broadcast band dxing for nearly 30 years, I just began listening to the FM band about 2 years ago. To date, I have logged 258 stations in 26 states and Mexico, with 207 of them verified by the stations.

McCook is located in the southwest corner of Nebraska. We have a population here of around 9000 people and are an agricultural center.
