Thank you very much for your letter, dated May 7, 1977, reporting reception of Radio Station KAZY-FM. This time, I am happy to say, we have verified your report. I do hope this verification will make a nice addition to your collection.

We do not have any QSL cards printed for our FM station because we just don't get very many reports for it. I hope you will accept one of our AM QSL's along with this letter as your verification of reception of Radio Station KAZY-FM.

KAZY operates 24 hours a day with 94,000 watts of power in the horizontal plane and 100,000 watts in the main power lobes. We use both horizontal and vertical antenna polarization. Our antenna is about 7,200 feet above sea level.

Again, thanks for writing. I do hope you will hear KAZY many times in the future.
