Thank you for the letter and reception report. It's good to hear from you again. I answered one of your reports when I was working for KAZY-FM. You sent me some information on the TV-FM DX group. I had not had the chance to thank you for the information until now. Anyway, thank you!

As for the report for KLAJ-FM, we have verified the information, and I'm quite happy in sending the verification card back to you. Since you heard the station, the call letters and format have been changed. We are now a mellow rock station and are no longer simulcasting with our AM station. We are now operating with a new antenna system from a new location. Our power output is 100,000 watts from an elevation of about 7,000 feet above sea level.
