

IT IS SURPRISING THAT YOU WERE RECEIVING OUR SIGNAL IN THE MANCOS VALLEY AREA, HOWEVER, WE HAVE FOUND THAT IN THIS MOUNTAIN COUNTRY OF SOUTHWESTERN COLORADO, THAT FM SIGNALS BOUNCE OFF OF MOUNTAINS AND THEREFORE, IT IS SOMEWHAT UNPREDICTABLE AS TO THE EXACT PATTERNS AND AREAS OF RECEPTION. WE HAVE HAD MANY OF OUR LISTENERS TELL US THAT THEY HAVE INSTALLED OUTDOOR ANTENNAS JUST SO THAT THEY CAN BETTER PULL IN THE KSUT SIGNAL.
