Thank you for your reception report dated May 18, 1977. I am pleased to note your report is correct and am verifying reception by way of this letter. I have checked the program log of KXXK for the period of time 12:48--1:15 am MDT and note that the programming you mentioned does "eheck out".

KXXK operates presently with 51 kw ERP in each plane from a transmitter site atop Lookout Mountain, west of Denver. I would guess that your reception of KX is rare, due to a bounce off the F1 or lower layer above the earth.
