I am very pleased to report reception of your FM station by me in McCook this date January 25, 1979 on 95.5 Mhz. The following is what I was able to log on your signal:

- 9:42 A.M. EST "Somebody Special" by Donna Fargo ended. Time given. weather summary followed by ad for J & J Center Wrestling tonight at 8:30 featuring Ga. championship between Thunderbolt Patterson and Oley Anderson. Located in Athens, Ga. on Commerce Road.
- 9:43 Ad for Custom Mart Interiors in Great Acres Center. Gave temperature as 24 degrees in Athens. Olivia-Newton-John record played.
- 9:47 Ad for Levis. Said to listen for the Leo Dillon Night Show at 8. "Your Kind of Radio, WNGC". Country music continued.

Your signal was coming in with following clarity: very good but gradually faded out. Other S/C/ N.C./TN stations in at the time for a rare winter E Skip opening.


Would appreciate it very much if you would send me a card or letter of verification on my reception of your radio station. I have enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience in replying. Thank you very much for this favor.

Although I have been broadcast band dxing for nearly 30 years, I just began listening to the FM band about 2 years ago. To date, I have logged 246 stations in 25 states and Mexico, with 206 of them verified by the stations. I have heard 8 other Georgia FM stations.

McCook Is located in the southwest corner of Nebraska. We have a population here of around 9000 people and are an agricultural center.

Will be looking forward to hearing from you soon. Good luck to you in your future broadcasting activities.
