Dear Sir:

We appreciate hearing about your reception of our station and are most happy to verify your report.

In 1975 we installed a new Collins 831-F2 , 10,000 watt transmitter and increased our licensed power to 9,800 watts at 97.9 MHz. The transmitter feeds a new Collins 37CP 12 bay antenna for an effective radiated power of 62,000 watts H & V. The antenna is mounted on a relatively short 152 foot tower, but sits on a high elevation East of Sioux City, Iowa, for maximum coverage area.

Our programming is fully automated with capability for live Stereo operation or Simulcasting with our sister station KMNS AM, at 620 kHz.

Again, we thank you for your report, and happy listening.
