Congratulations! Your reception report was checked against station logs and found correct.


This letter will verify your reception of KFNF on July 27, 1977 from 7:52 P.M. CDT to 8:05 P.M. CDT, our first official broadcasting day.

KFNF operates with 100,000 watts ERP on a frequency of 101.1 MHZ, from studios and transmitting apparatus located 6 miles west of Oberlin, KS. on highway 36.

Transmitting apparatus includes a Collins 831G-2 20 KW transmitter and a Collins GSCPS-10A 10 section antennae side mounted on a 450 foot tower.
