Dear Radio Friends:

I am very pleased to report reception of your FM station by me in McCook this date Aug. 13, 1978, on 99.5 Mhz. The following is what I was able to log on your signal:

- 2:47 A.M. CDT message on job service. ID as "WLOL-FM time is 2:47" played "I'll Never Fall In Love Again".
- 2:50 Played "For The Good Times" and "Close To You"
- 2:58 spot for Minnesota Dept. of Health and Immunization.
- 3:00 "Weather on Stereo 100-WLOL Where the Good Music Is"
- 4:27 Weather summary, "Day & Night, it's Beautiful music and Stereo 100 WLOL-FM".

Your signal was coming through with the following clarity:

Weak when first tuned in but became stronger as you went. Still heard at 10:00 A.M. Sunday morning as numerous IA/MN/SD/MO stations all over dial during this period.

Would appreciate it very much if you would send me a card or letter of confirmation on my reception of your radio station. I have enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience in replying. Thank you very much for this favor.

Although I have been Dxing on the broadcast band and short wave for many years, I just began listening on FM last summer. To date, I have logged 230 stations in 25 states and Mexico, with 118 of them being confirmed.

Will be looking forward to hearing from you soon. Good luck to you in your future broadcasting activities.
