
Dear Bill;

Thanks for your letter reporting reception of **KCLR-FM** radio on July 5, 1994 from Mancos, CO. I once spent countless hours Dxing FM and TV stations. We don't get as many sporadic E Skip reports as we once did. I think it's because the FM dial is becoming so crowded and people have pushbuttons to tune with. I did experience sporadic skip here on or about the same day, I heard FM from south Florida (Ft. Lauderdale/Miami) and Utah (Salt Lake City) at the same time. From Mid Missouri skip most frequently comes from south Texas, south Florida, Boston, Salt Lake City, Montana and Saskatchewan. On rare occasions I would receive skip from as close as Denver, usually it was more distant. Cuba and Mexico were frequent as well. My brother and I logged several hundred television stations in the late 60's and early 70's. Occasionally Tropospheric skip could allow us to receive stations several hundred miles away. Records on "T" skip include New Orleans and Washington DC.

I can easily confirm your reception July 5th, 1994 as being **KCLR-FM**, licensed to **Boonville, MO**. The only correction is the first commercial you identified is Joe **Machens** (not Mackin) Ford. **KCLR-FM** is owned by Zimmer Broadcasting of Cape Girardeau, MO and operates at 99.3 Mhz with 32 kw at 600'HAAT.

I've enclosed a bumper sticker and my business card. We also operate **KCMQ-FM 96.7** and **KTGR-AM 1580 Khz**, both stations are licensed to Columbia, MO. Let me know if you ever receive those stations. Good Luck.
