- 8:06 Mentioned Vance Senior High School Graduation tonight at 8:00. Read marriage licenses and divorces.
- 8:07 court news
- 8:09 ad for ventilation fans
- 8:10 obituaries such as Mary Elizabeth Williams and Dwight A Raney of Watkins Community.
- 8:13 weather for Henderson and vicinity. Signal faded.

The reception was with the following clarity:  
Outstanding steady signal for first 7 or 8 minutes and then gradually began to fade. VA and NC stations in tonight on several frequencies.

My reception of your station is # 72 on the FM band. I have been a broadcast band dxer for 27 years but just began listening to FM although I have had a receiver for many years. My receiver is a GE Multiplex Am/Fm receiver using TV antenna.
