I am very pleased to confirm your reception report of June 11, 1986.


Your information is quite accurate. KDSU-FM is the Public Radio Voice of North Dakota State University and was the first non-commercial FM station in North Dakota.

KDSU-FM began broadcasting on January 17, 1966 with an effective radiated power of 1,260 watts from the campus of NDSU.

On June 9, 1982, KDSU-FM began broadcasting from its new transmitting facility located 20 miles NW of Fargo. KDSU-FM broadcasts at 100,000 watts with a Harris FM-25K transmitter and Harris FMH-10AC(ERI) 10 bay CP antenna side mounted at the 1000 foot level on the Prairie Public Television tower 1.25 miles NE of Amenia, ND.
