
Dear Mr. Nittler:

Thank you for your letter of August 24, 1978, reporting reception of KFAH-FM on 92.1 Mhz in your home at McCook. The log information provided in your letter does verify your reception of KFAH on the date of August 24, 1978.

As you may know we are a Class A-FM, transmitting at 3,000 watts of effective radiated power. Our three bay antenna sits atop a 273 foot tower. Our signal normally reaches out in 80 miles in all directions but West and Northwest of Alliance. So your reception of our signal comes as a pleasant surprise to us.

We do appreciate very much your taking time to let us know of the reception of KFAH by you, and regret this letter has been delayed. Inadvertantly it got misplaced.
