I am very pleased to report reception of your FM Radio Station on 100.7 Mc. by me in McCook on June 27, 1977. The following is what I was able to log on your programming:

- 8:24 A.M. CDT religious program with speaker, seemed to be using theme, "Christians Must Be Ready".
- 8:28 hymn "Be Thou With Them"
- 8:34 identified program as Back To Bible Broadcast with Herman Ross and gave mailing address in Lincoln.
- 8:35 "This program was sponsored by Good News Broadcasting Association. 8:35 now, you're listening to KGBI-FM in Omaha. 78 under clear skies in Omaha. Lincoln reporting sunny and".....

(my tape recorder ran out at this point as I had to go to work at 8:30, I left it running to get station ID.)

The reception was with the following clarity:


Very good reception but with some side band interference from semi-local KXXX in Colby, KS on 100.3.

My reception of your station is # 75 on the FM band. I have been a broadcast band dxer for 27 years but just began listening to FM although I have had a receiver for many years. My receiver is a GE Multiplex Am/Fm receiver using TV antenna.

Would appreciate it very much if you would send me a card or letter of verification on my reception of your station. I have enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope for your convenience in replying. Thank you very much for this favor.

Will be looking forward to hearing from you soon. Good luck to you in your future broadcasting activities.
