Thank you so much for your reception report of September 29, 1977. Please consider this letter verification; the program material that you received matches our official station log.

Concerning our station, we are broadcasting 24 hours a day with 100,000 watts non-directional FM stereo. Our transmitter is a Gates FM20H3 20kw feeding an eleven bay antenna at the top of our 500 foot tower. The tower's elevation above ground level added to the base height of 963 feet AMSL yields a total elevation of 1463 AMSL.

Our programming is totally Christian within the framework of an "inspirational" sound, relating 24 hours a day that God really loves you, and has a perfect plan for your life if you will turn to him.

Again, thank you, and we hope that you will tune in again the next time the skip is in. God bless you.
