8:06 Gordon Lightfoot music.

The interest that I have in this hobby goes back to 1950 when I began dxing on the AM band. I have heard more than 3000 AM stations in 61 countries and have verifications from over 2740 stations. On FM, I have heard over 240 stations in the past two years with 190 verifications received.

I thank you sincerely for your efforts and wish you continued success in your broadcasting activities.
