Good Morning!

Thanks for your letter of reception of KLCC on July 7, 1996. This is to confirm your submitted data with one minor exception: the name of the local host of NPR's Weekend Edition is Nancy Solomon, rather than Nancy Sullivan. However there's no question in my mind of your reception.

We have a satellite transmitter (KLCO-FM) at Newport, Oregon which is at the coast. It has an ERP of 3.2 Kw and a very good transmission location. We received a phone call one day from a DXer just east of Seattle who said he was receiving our programming. The General Manager responded with some comment that KLCC, with an ERP of 81 Kw, has quite a range. The response was that it was not 89.7 that was being listened to, but rather 90.5, which is the KLCO frequency. He couldn't hear 89.7 at that time even though he tried!
