Thank you for your reception report. This letter confirms you did indeed hear our station.

KPAM-FM Operates with 100kw H & V using an RCA BFC-5 antenna and a RCA BTF-40E1 transmitter. The power into the antenna is about 39 KW.

KPAM AM operates on 1410 KHZ during daytime hours. The AM station operates at 5 KW nondirectional. KPAM-AM is one of the first stations in the country to order one of RCA'S all solid state 5 KW transmitters. WE hope to be on the air with the new transmitter about next April.
