As a fellow dx-er it's my job around here (among other things) to answer letters such as yours.

FM dx reports are rare, thus you get a personalized letter rather than the form letter or QSL card we use for the AM station.

The logo for WSM, consisting of the letters 'w', 's', and 'm' in a stylized, lowercase, rounded font.

This letter confirms your reception of WSM-FM at 11:00AM on June 3, 1985. The information you supplied corresponds with our program and commercial logs for that particular time.

Your record of stations received is most impressive. You're obviously very serious about your hobby.

As to my dx conquests, I have no idea what the numbers would be for AM & FM as I merely dabble with that aspect when my first love...tv dx-ing...is dormant.

I have logged 212 U.S., Canadian and Mexican tv stations in the past 10 years; and have about 1/2 of them recorded on VHS videotape.

One of my reports that might be of interest to you happened a couple of years ago when Channel 5 from Pueblo/Colorado Springs overpowered our local Channel 5 signal. Channel 2 from Denver and Channel 3 from both Sterling and Glenwood Springs are frequent visitors here in Middle Tennessee.
