As Chief Engineer of KAMX (Previously KFGI, KPTY, KAPT, etc.) I appreciate your interest in AM & FM DX'ing. I got in to this business through DX'ing and Ham Radio.

In reference to your reception report for June 21, 1996, I must tell you that our logs of commercials played is computerized in nature, and since we have limited ability to archive such information, it is deleted from our system when it is about 3 months old. However, I do still have logs for that date which show two of the ads you mention scheduled for that time. The Red McComb's ad you mention is on the schedule for the next hour, however, it is quite possible that the operator could have moved that commercial to play earlier for programming purposes.

Based on this information, I will verify your reception of our station on 94.7 MHz. (current call sign KAMX).
