



Indeed, it appears as though you may have heard our FM radio station from your location, although it is definitely not something we intended to make happen. One interesting point is that we actually have two radio stations in the same building, with their respective antennae only a few miles apart, so perhaps you'll hear our other radio station someday as well. The weather patterns are rather different this year from most; that together with a lot of odd VHF propagation in our area would lead me personally to believe you'll probably continue to receive lots of other stations from across the TX-LA area for as long as the weather conditions permit. In fact, several NBFM stations in the 144-174 band locally are "skipping" all over the NE Texas area this year, and I would expect that is part of the same weather pattern, perhaps you could even receive those, although most are extremely low powered compared to our signal.
