Radio Voice of the Gospel — Station ETLF — is a Christian broadcasting service supported by contributions from churches in various parts of the world. Programs are approximately 70% informational and 30% religious in character, and are produced in local studios in the target areas of Africa, Asia and the Near East. Technical facilities include a 40 acre studio-administration and staff residence campus located 10 kilometers from the center of Addis Ababa. The two 100 kilowatt shortwave transmitters are located 30 kilometers from the studios on a 300 acre site on which there is also erected a network of dual-band curtain antennas for external broadcasts and quadrant antennas for regional transmissions. Programs include 12-13 hours shortwave broadcasts in 13 languages per day and a four-hour medium wave service for Addis Ababa.
