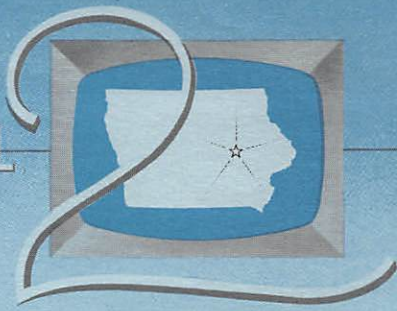

Dear Mr. Nitler:

We sincerely appreciated receiving your report of reception of WMT-TV Channel 2.

WMT-TV is operating with 100,000 watts power, maximum permitted for VHF channels 2 through 6. The first program on WMT-TV was transmitted September 30, 1953. At that time we began with 100,000 watts power and were the first television station in the United States to begin operation with the 100,000 watts power.

The transmitting antenna has an areal height of 702 feet above the ground, which places the antenna beacon light 1552 feet above sea level. WMT-TV Channel 2 is assigned the operating frequency of 54 to 60 megacycles.

Your report of the reception of WMT-TV was certainly appreciated and if you should be in this area at any time, we extend to you our invitation to visit us.
