mospheric peculiarities, signals will travel extremely long distances.

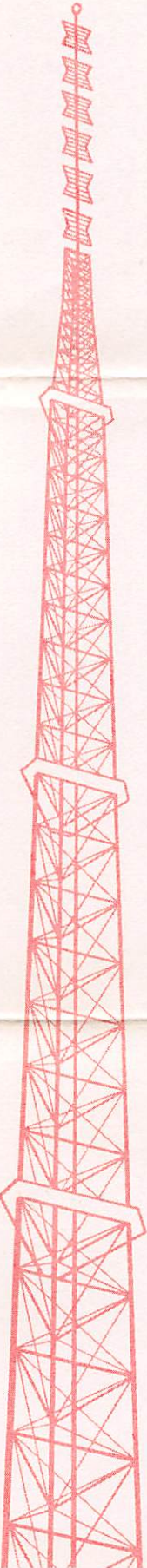
We appreciate your letter since we are always interested in finding
