Thanks very much for your letter on the reception of our station. We get many cards and letters from all over the U. S. and Canada. Our transmitter tower is 547 feet high, and we broadcast with the power of 100,000 Kilowatts. We are located on the high plains of West Texas, about halfway between Dallas and El Paso. We believe we have the longest privately owned microwave system in operation, namely 118 air miles, from Lubbock, Texas, to the Air Terminal at Midland, Texas.
