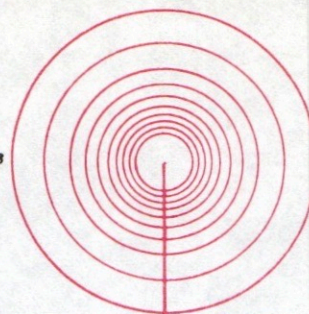

Dear Sir:

This confirms your reception report of March 18, 1968 on 1340 Khz from 0200 to 0300 AM MST.

KCAP uses a Collins 20V3 transmitter at One Kilowatt daytime and 250 watts night time. We are located in the Southwestern area of the Helena Valley and find that our signal tends to radiate northeasterly for that reason. The high mountains to the south west provide a considerable amount of attenuation.

Thank you for your reception report. We were very happy to provide the test at the times requested by your club. It is interesting to discover how far beyond the normal coverage area our station can reach after daylight hours.

We would like to invite you to visit our facility at 9 North Last Chance Gulch if you are ever in the Capitol city.
