Dear Mr. Sampson;

This is a verification of your reception of our AM signal Saturday, January 28, 1967.

Here's a little information concerning the type of equipment used on KONG-AM. We have a Bauer transmitter that employs a pair of 4-400 tubes as modulators, and a pair of 4-400's as final amplifiers. We, as so many local frequency operations are now doing, operate at a thousand watts in the daytime and switch to 250 at night.

Our studios and offices are located down-town at Mooney Boulevard and Walnut Avenue near the new Visalia Fair Shopping Center. Our Transmitter is located north of town on the St. Johns river. In the daytime we operate simulcast with KONG-FM, which incidentally was the first stereo operation in the San Joaquin Valley, and split the operation in the evening to operate both stations independantly.

It was indeed a pleasure to hear from you and your report of where our signal is going, and if you have the occasion to visit Visalia we would invite you to drop by and see us.
