Thank you very much for your letter of Sunday, September 4, reporting your reception of KTHO. I am pleased to verify your report.

KTHO (AM) operates with a two-tower directional pattern, with the transmitter located in Tahoe Valley, California, at the southwest edge of Lake Tahoe. The transmitter power is 1000 watts; the towers are 300-ft tall, beaming the power mostly toward the northeast or Reno, Nevada. It is most interesting to learn of your reception in Cupertino! Our pattern "null", or dead-spot, is in your area....
