I am pleased to report reception of your station on Monday, February 27, 1967
from 11:58 PM to 12:05 AM Hawaiian Time on 1490 kcs.

(This is really) Items and announcements heard on this broadcast are as follows:

- 11:58 Song - "I Left My Heart in San Francisco"
- 12:00 A station ID was given & then a news cast started - you faded until 12:02 1/2
- 12:02 1/2 Midnite type chimes, then vocal music & your sign-off announcement was given. I was able to copy part of it - as follows - "... Radio station KTOH comes to the end of another broadcast day. KTOH is owned & operated by ... (you faded for about 10 seconds) & we invite you to join us again tomorrow morning for another day of broadcast. Until then, on behalf of the staff & management ... (you faded again)"
- 12:03 1/2 The musical "Aloha" was broadcast, & you seemed to leave the air about 12:05

You were quite weak - I think the only reason I could hear you is that interference on 1490 kcs here on Monday mornings is almost negligible.

 Antenna: 4 1/2 foot loop used to peak you
 Interference: Heavy from several all night mainland stations.
 Atmospheric noise: None Fading: As indicated Readability: poor
 Temperature 40 degrees. Weather clear
