
Dear John,

I'm sorry you failed to receive our earlier confirmation of reception.

This letter will confirm your reception of KWXY on April 30, 1967 --10:57 to 10:59 P.M. on 1340 kilocycles.

A folded unipole antenna is similar to half of a folded dipole. The tower base is grounded directly. A skirt of six wires spaced eight inches from the tower is connected to the tower at the top. The lower end of the skirt is fed against the ground. Of course, the skirt is insulated by stand-offs all the way down the tower. This gives a high radiation resistance, low loss, wide bandwidth, and some gain.
